- Introduce students to various computer experiences for the purpose of increasing knowledge, skills and abilities in use of English Language software.
- Monitor activities and behavior of students during computer laboratories to ensure adherence to appropriate conduct and use of computers.
- Perform related duties as assigned
- Maintain an attractive and functional lab; perform preventative maintenance on computers, including weekly cleaning of mouse, screens and keyboards.
- Maintain confidentiality of all students receiving services.
