

# **Immigrant Hope Santa Barbara (IHSB) Citizenship Tutor Job Description**

## **Position Summary**

Tutors will plan and implement tutoring sessions for individuals who are applying for U.S. citizenship. In a one-on-one setting, tutors help students study naturalization materials including U.S. History and Civics and increase their skills in speaking, reading, writing, and understanding English.

## **Qualifications**

- College Students
- Will consider a high school degree or Honor Society Students with recommendations from Teacher or Pastor
- Able to pass a background check (with proof of identification)
- Fluency in English
- Good communication skills and the ability to explain concepts
- Work well with other tutors and staff
- Patience; the ability to adapt to different learning styles
- Awareness of cultural differences
- Enthusiasm for teaching and learning
- Agreement with the mission and vision of IHSB

## **Responsibilities**

- Attend tutor orientation and training
- Plan lessons and activities
- Give individual attention to the learner's educational needs
- Establish a good rapport with student(s) and other tutors
- Keep records and provide information about student progress
- Meet with supervisor regularly to discuss student needs and progress
- Refer the learner to the staff for needs other than tutoring

## **Time Commitment**

Tutors commit on average six months of tutoring, averaging approximately four hours per week.
